

HOMECOMING PARADE REGULATIONS

- 1) Students may ride in the parade as a class on a flatbed (only if it has side railing), in cars, or trucks. The large vehicles carrying classes must have a minimum of three adult chaperones including one teacher. Students must not ride on the top of the cabs of trucks or on top of hoods or trunks of cars. Students must be seated on the bed of a pick-up truck, not on the sides. There must be at least one parent/teacher in the back of every truck, including personal trucks.
- 2) All participants (drivers and passengers) must complete and return permission forms with parade entry forms. ***No one will be allowed to participate without this form being completed.*** Forms are to be returned by 3:00pm on Thursday, September 25th. - 3) Noisemakers and horns are encouraged.
- 4) No one will be allowed to leave during school hours on the day of the parade to obtain materials for decorations.
- 5) A map of the parade route will be given to all participating vehicles as well as instructions for lining up. On the morning of the parade, each float captain is responsible for obtaining their float line-up number from Ms. Delcambre. ***Without a float number, your vehicle will not be allowed into the parade area!***
- 6) Students are reminded to please mark clearly their grade level on the right side of their spirit float so that the judges will be able to identify them.
- 7) Trash cans have been provided on the parade grounds for last minute decorating items. Please make use of these and help us present a tidy campus for the visitors that evening.
- 8) On the evening of the parade, everyone should report to his or her vehicles for instructions by the parade marshal and police no later than 4:00pm. Vehicles can begin lining up in the designated area at 3:30pm and drivers must be in their vehicles in line by 4:00pm.

- 10) **Anyone wishing to enter a vehicle in the Homecoming Parade must fill out and return the entry form (found at <http://www.chspanthers.com> to Ms. Delcambre by 3:00pm on Thursday, Sept. 25. No vehicles will be allowed to enter after this time!!!**

MOST IMPORTANT:

Students are reminded that once the parade is in progress, they are to remain in their designated positions. They are to drive slowly and with great caution. Since this is a school event, all school rules apply.
