**UL Lafayette** is hosting two **Preview Day Activities**. This activity will include walking tours and bus tours of campus, academic and extracurricular information, previews of academic colleges with an opportunity to meet with faculty. In addition there will be sessions on scholarships, TOPS, financial aid, honors and housing. The first Preview day is October 8th, 2011 and the second is Saturday, November 19, 2011. **UL Lafayette** has also sent information on **freshman scholarships** as well as applications for scholarships. The final deadline for applying for Academic Scholarships is January 31, 2012. The priority deadline to apply is November 15, 2011. The eligibility requirements include: ACT composite of at least 23 or Sat of 1050, Minimum cum GPA of 3.0, and English ACT of 18 or verbal SAT 450, Math ACT of 19 or Math SAT 460. The students must have applied for admissions to the university before being considered for a scholarship. All students meeting the eligibility criteria must also submit a completed scholarship application. ACT/SAT taken after Jan 31st will not be considered in the evaluation process.
